# What is deforestation?

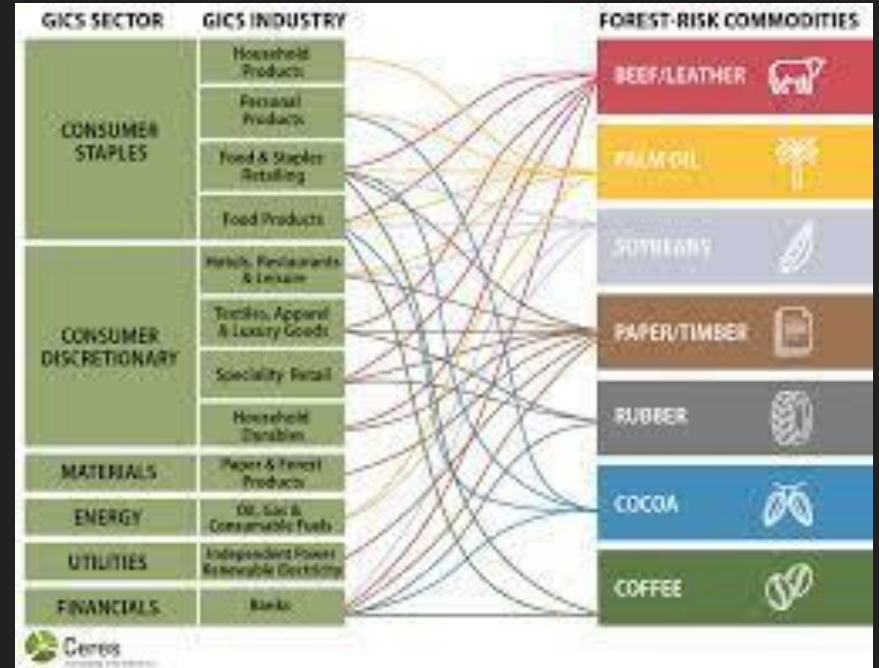
Deforestation is removing forest from land for used them for farming products.
